About ITSMS Auditor / Lead Auditor Training Course

This training course is designed for those who wish to become IT Service Management System (ITSMS) auditor/Lead Auditor and is based on ISO 20000-1:2005

Successful qualification in Auditor / Lead Auditor training course is a pre-requisite for IRCA empanelment of ITSMS Auditors.

This training course is an IRCA (International Register of Certificated Auditors) approved training course for Auditors / Lead Auditors. (Approval Number A17448)

Course Objectives

To gain knowledge & skill for conducting ITSMS audits. **Knowledge**:

- 1. Explain the purpose of an Information Technology Service Management System including policies, process-based framework with linked activities to enable the effective management and implementation of all information technology services.
- 2. Explain the purpose, content and interrelationship of ISO/IEC 20000-1 Part 1 Specification and ISO/IEC 20000-2 Part 2 Code of Practice and ISO/IEC 17799:2005 and ISO/IEC TR 18044:2004.
- 3. Explain the role of an ITSMS Auditor to plan, conduct, report and follow up an Information Technology Service Management System audit in accordance with ISO 19011.

Skills:

- 1. Interpret the requirement of ISO/IEC 20000-1 Part 1 in the context of application to an audit
- Plan, conduct, report and follow up an Information Technology Service Management system audit to the ISO/IEC 20000-1 Part 1 Standard in accordance with ISO 19011 Guidelines for Auditors and by interpreting ISO/IEC 20000-1 Part

Successful qualification in both is essential to qualify for Auditor / Lead Auditor certificate. Successful participants will be awarded IIQM, STQC certificate with IRCA logo on it.
